We have the honor to invite you to the **Seventh Global Forum of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC),** which takes place in Baku, Azerbaijan, on 26-27 April, 2016. The Forum will be preceded by a Youth Event on 25 April, 2016.

The overarching theme of the Forum is "Living Together In Inclusive Societies: A Challenge and A Goal". The event will bring together nearly 3,000 participants, including political leaders, representatives of international and regional organizations, the private sector, civil society, academia, youth, arts and the media, as well as donor agencies and foundations.
